The exhibition *bauhaus.film.expanded* is online

Live-discussions every Thursday and Sunday,
6 pm: zkm.de/livestream

ZKM's homage to the moving-image world of the Bauhaus, which opened in February, will be digitally accessible as of April 16, 2020. Due to the current situation, the ZKM will digitally present more than 50 Bauhaus films, which are part of the exhibition curated by Markus Heltschl, Thomas Tode, and Peter Weibel, and expand them with a program of talks by experts and short lectures.

»bauhaus.film.digitally.expanded«, initiated and curated by Teresa Retzer, makes the majority of the exhibition films accessible online. Many of these films were thought to be lost and have not yet been shown in their original form. Many of the works have been newly digitized and restored for the exhibition and can be seen for the first time in their correct projection speed, color, and sound.

From April 16, 2020 to May 17, 2020, the live program, which is moderated by Teresa Retzer, will take place every Thursday and Sunday at 6 p.m. In addition to the curators of the exhibition, other Bauhaus film experts, including Stefan Drößler, Jeannine Fiedler, Boris Friedewald, Jan Knopf, Martin Reinhart, Rolf Sachsse and Paula Schwerdtfeger, as well as the filmmakers Jutta Hercher and Maria Hemmleb, will participate in this program.

Until May 7, 2020, a thematic section of the physical exhibition will be published online every Thursday. Starting with »Expanded Forms of Film«, followed by »Political and Experimental Film Essays« and »Architectural Films«, the publication of the exhibition films ends with the »Abstract Films« as the artistic highlight. The films will be available online until the preliminary end of the exhibition on May 17, 2020. The film releases will be accompanied by live discussions at 6 p.m. On May 7, for example, Malte Hagener, Professor of Media Studies at the Philipps University of Marburg and Stefan Drößler, film historian and director of the Munich Film Museum, will discuss the exhibition's »Abstract Films« with Markus Heltschl. In addition, there will also be a live discussion with Markus Heltschl, Dorcas Müller and Martin Koerber on Thursday, May 14, about the screening and preservation of historical (Bauhaus) films.
